If more students apply than Strong Foundations can accept, then a lottery will be conducted for the spaces. Students not selected by lottery but wishing to attend will be placed on a wait list. For any openings that become available, students on the wait list will have first choice. Applications are being accepted for Readiness (age 5 by September 30, 2019) and Grades One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six, Seven and Eight.
